Accommodation

The Polytechnic does not provide on-campus accommodation. **Students are strongly encouraged to make their own accommodation arrangements.**

Be prepared to pay between S\$500.00-S\$700.00 per month for a single room and S\$300 and above for twin-sharing. Students are normally expected to pay at least one-month advance rent and one-month deposit. In some cases, tenants are required to pay the legal fees to execute a tenancy agreement.

Transportation

With the Mass Rapid System (MRT), Public buses and Taxi, travelling in Singapore is easy and comfortable. A Guide (The Transitlink Guide) for Bus & MRT service is available at the MRT station counters.

The nearest MRT stations to Temasek Polytechnic are Bedok and Tampines MRT stations, located just next to respective Bus Interchanges. Feeder buses ply between interchanges and our campus.

Medical Service

In case of emergency, medical services are easily accessible in Singapore:

- a) Government Polyclinics
- b) Hospitals
- c) Private clinics

Living Expenses

The following is a general guideline of estimated expenditure for a month in Singapore dollars :

Your living expenses is estimated to be between S\$1,100 - S\$1,700 per month. These costs are mere estimates, subject to variation according to individual's lifestyle. **It is important that students should be able to support themselves financially during their course of study and stay in Singapore.**

EMPLOYMENT FOR FULL-TIME INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

Full time undergraduates of Polytechnics and Universities are allowed to work part-time of up to 16 hours per week during school term and work full time during vacation as the Ministry of Manpower has exempted them from applying for work permits. There is no necessity to obtain any permission from the Student's Liaison/Affairs Office of their respective Polytechnics.

HOSPITALISATION AND SURGICAL INSURANCE

The cost of hospitalisation in Singapore is very expensive for international students. It is compulsory for you to buy a Hospitalisation and Surgical Insurance to minimise unexpected medical expenses. This policy will cover hospitalisation expenses due to illness and/or accidental injuries. However, the policy does not cover pre-existing medical conditions and congenital anomalies. You will pay the insurance premium together with your tuition fee. The estimated insurance premium is from S\$35 – S\$50 per year.

STUDENT PASS / VISA

Upon successful application to Temasek Polytechnic, you will receive the information on how to apply for your student's pass in your Enrolment Package.

Once your online application for student's pass is approved by the Singapore Immigration and Checkpoint Authority, we will send you the in-principle approval (IPA) letter. The IPA letter will serve as a visa for you to enter Singapore.

TUITION FEE

Tuition fee is about S\$19,642 per year for full-fee paying students. Students with excellent results and who do not already hold a diploma or higher qualification will be eligible to apply for the government tuition grant for our full-time courses.

The above fees are subjected to annual revision by the Singapore Government.

TUITION GRANT

Successful applicants will be informed of the details of application after their enrolment into Temasek Polytechnic. Tuition Grant holders are bonded to work for 3 years in Singapore upon completion of the course. Graduates can seek employment on their own in both private and public sectors.

Two sureties are required to execute the Tuition Grant Deed. They can be of any nationality but must be above 21 years below 65 years of age and must not be bankrupts.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Q1 How can I apply for exemptions?

A No exemptions will be given. All international students are admitted to the first year of study.

Q2 Is there any age limitation?

A The full-time diploma courses offered by the Polytechnics are targeted mainly at fresh school leavers from secondary schools or ITE in Singapore. Applicants meeting the requisite requirements are considered for admissions based on merit and subject to vacancy available. Mature students are encouraged to consider taking up part-time courses. If they are granted admissions to the full-time diploma courses, they are expected to be able to work with their younger classmates, generally in the age group of 17 -19 years old, in their course of study and particularly during group discussions/project work.

Q3 How many international students does Temasek Polytechnic admit each academic year?

A The number of international students admitted to Temasek Polytechnic each academic year is set at 10% of the total intake.

Q4 When are classes held and for how long?

A Classes are usually conducted between 8.00am to 6.00pm on Mondays to Fridays with about 24-30 contact hours per week.

Q5 What are the obligations of my Tuition Grant surety? Is he liable to pay in the event that I default?

A The main obligation of the surety is to ensure that the student fulfils his obligations of the bond. If the student defaults, the surety will have to pay the tuition grant subsidy the student received plus 10% compound interest.

Q6 Is scholarship available?

A TP offers a range of prestigious scholarships to full-time students who have excelled academically and with proven track record in co-curricular activities or in other area of talents like sports. Q7 Is there financial assistance scheme(s) available for International Students?

A Yes. The Tuition Fee Loan is also open to Full-time International Students who are Tuition Grant holders. Under this scheme, student can apply for a loan of up to 75% of the tuition fees payable for the whole course of study. One guarantor is required. The guarantor must either be a Singaporean or Singapore Permanent Resident and is at least 21 years of age and shall not exceed 60 years of age. The application form will be made available to you in the Enrolment package. Please note that the approval is subject to the rules and regulations of the bank.
