1 A broad and relevant curriculum, for work and life



On top of their diploma-related studies, your child will also undergo TP Fundamentals (TPFun), a set of subjects to equip them with crucial life skills to succeed in a 21st-century workforce. These include areas such as leadership, critical

4 More options for further studies and skills deepening



Today, your child can access a broader range of post-diploma options after graduating from TP. For example, they can pursue a SkillsFuture Work-Study Programme (WSP), which supports their transition into the workforce. In addition, WSPs give

TP has also partnered with Singapore University of Technology and Design (SUTD) to administer the TP-SUTD Pathway Programme. Applicable for some diploma courses offered by our Schools of Engineering and Applied Science, students in these courses will be given the choice to take SUTD modules in their final semester. 

The best **Joint Admissions Exercise (JAE)** advice you can give your child



1 MERs and ELR2B2

Your child must meet the Minimum Entry Requirements (MERs) of the TP diploma course he or she is applying for.

Polytechnic application is also dependent on his/her O-Level aggregate scores computation, commonly known as ELR2B2. For details on ELR2B2 computation, tap [HERE](#).

2 Aggregate score range

These figures showcase the net ELR2B2 aggregate score range of the lowest and highest ranked students who were admitted to these courses through the previous year's JAE.

Meant as a reference only, they do not constitute the admissions scores for subsequent admissions exercises. You can view the aggregate score range for TP's diploma courses [HERE](#).

3 Use up all 12 choices

Do advise your child to utilise all 12 choices fully. Even if they're confident of getting into their course of choice, the demand for places can be unpredictable.



4 Follow the heart but be practical too

Your child's first few choices should reflect the fields that they are passionate about.

As demand can be very stiff for some courses, the rest of their options should include those that they would most likely qualify for, taking into account the previous year's aggregate score range of these courses.

5 Talk to our experts
