Shrimp Health through Best Farm Management Practices and Functional Feeds

Dr Nguyen Duy Hoa

Vietnam is one of the top-5 shrimp producers in the world. Despite disease and international market challenges, the industry has adapted both in new shrimp farming technologies and premium and/or functional feeds. The talk will cover the Vietnam shrimp market, shrimp diseases in Southeast Asia, solutions and approaches for shrimp disease management, best farm management practices, and trends in functional feeds with functional proteins and additives.

Dr Nguyen Duy Hoa is currently Global Technical Director, Empyreal & MOTIV Products, Cargill Inc. He received his PhD in Applied Biology Engineering (shrimp nutrition and domestication) from Ghent University, Belgium in 2009. Dr Hoa joined INVE in 2012 and developed a successful three-phase shrimp farming protocol in a heavy EMS area in Soc Trang. Between 2013 and 2016, he worked for Cargill Vietnam where he was involved in developing a best farm management package for shrimp (POM), designed, and developed, and launched new shrimp feed/feeding program, technical know-how and trained local staffs as well as developing local fish health management program. He has over 24 years of experience in aquaculture research and industry, including 18 years of working for the National Research Institute for Aquaculture in the South of Vietnam (RIA2). Dr Hoa is recipient to Award Certificates for the Aquaculture Research Achievement from the Vietnam Minister for Agriculture and Rural Development.
