After graduation, Mavis joined Certis Cisco Security Pte Ltd as an Aviation Security Officer and is presently excelling in her job at Changi Airport.

Mavis has an excellent attendance record and is always willing to go the extra mile to help passengers and colleagues he said.


She is humble and a good team player who works hand-in-hand with her peers. She is a good role model for others to follow.
