



Certificate in Security Operations

Course Overview

The WSQ Certificate in Security Operations is a competency-based training programme for unarmed frontline officers who are deployed to various locations or events to perform security functions. This programme is for security officers, senior security officers, protection officers and security screening officers.

Pre-Requisites

- Minimum Secondary 2 education
- Able to read and write English

Applicants who do not meet the pre-requisites may be required to take an entrance test during registration.

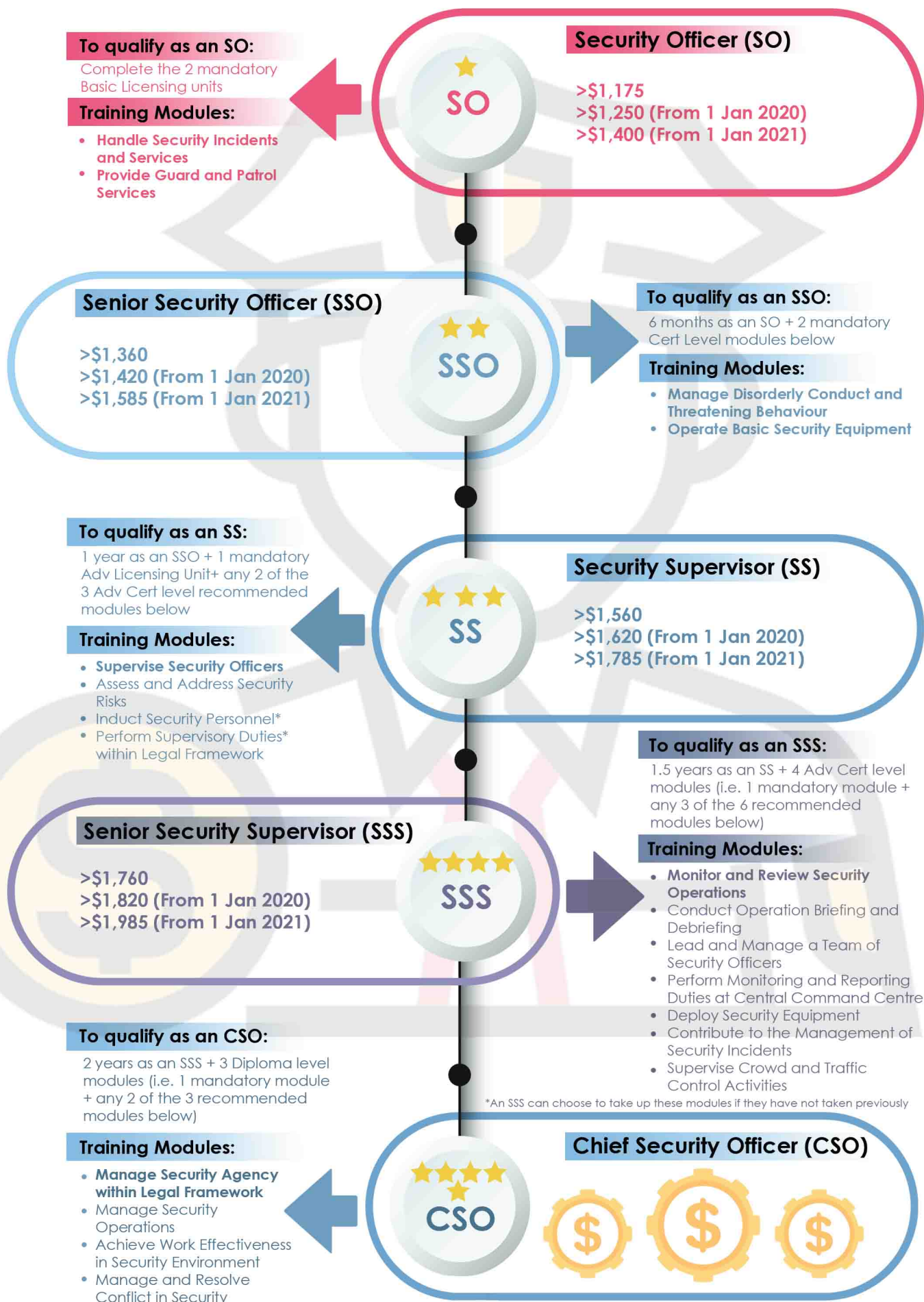

Note: PWM is applicable to all resident security personnel (Singaporeans/PRs) under contracts of service. Part time resident security personnel (i.e. those performing less than 35 hours of work per week) shall be paid accordingly to a pro-rated PWM salary.
